

Research Funding Awarded

The Government of Canada recently announced that University of British Columbia's <u>Dr. Farinaz Havaei</u> and Dr. Joanie Sims-Golds will lead an investigation to understand the impact and implementation of the "one high-risk site" staffing policies in long-term care homes (LTC). This was part of a larger announcement of \$1.8M in funding for implementation science research to understand the impact of efforts to keep LTC residents, their families and caregivers, and staff safe from COVID-19.




Glennis Zilm - UBC Alumni **Builder Award**
